a new mexican artist called Antingue Automata Mexicano who is releasing his debut album; microhate (background 043) this year, such as more stuff from australias Dave Miller,I who just finished his first electronic JAZZ full-length album recently, scheduled for beg. Of next year. Also planning an album with paul hammond of real soon (further details) for a touch of class for next year, definitely will continue releasing more material by Alan abrahams aka PORTABLE. I personally just finished a 12" for the french telegraph label aswell as a "Live @ Liquid room, tokyo" live cd of mine soon.
